



LADY MAYOR'S SHOW 2025

The Lady Mayor's Show will be taking place in the City of London on **Saturday 8th November 2025**. Roads will be closed to all traffic (including pedal cycles) on this day, so you will need to plan your travel in advance. The information here will help you understand how your journey might be affected.

About the Show

The Lady Mayor's Show includes a huge array of floats and performers with modern businesses, charities and community groups that represent the many different elements that make up the City of London taking part. For more information visit: <https://lordmayorsshow.london/>. There will be no fireworks display after the parade.

Road closure and re-opening times

The event route and many surrounding roads in your area will be closed to all traffic. Local access will be maintained for as long as possible, while access for emergency vehicles is always maintained.

All roads will be re-opened as soon as it is safe to do so. Estimated road closing & re-opening times are shown below (map on last page details full footprint):

Event route

All approaches to the event route will have restrictions in place, including measures in some areas to prevent or restrict vehicle access. Pedestrians might be redirected to alternative routes on the direction of stewards or police officer.

Road users

You are advised to avoid driving if possible. However, if you intend to drive on this date, please plan your route in advance and allow more time for your journey. (<https://tfl.gov.uk/plan-a-journey/>)

Walking & Cycling

Walking and cycling may be the easiest way to get around your local area. There will be crossing points along the route for pedestrians, and pavements alongside closed roads will be open as normal. **Cycles & E-Bikes/Scooters must not be used on the pavement or on a closed road.**

Please do not lock your bike up anywhere on the parade route.

Accessibility

There is a free dedicated viewing area for disabled people and their families at the junction of Old Bailey and Ludgate Hill. Please note that these are not under cover, so visitors are recommended to bring umbrellas and waterproof clothing.

No seating is provided but folding chairs can be brought. Areas around St Paul's and Mansion House are normally busy with spectators, but Fleet Street, Victoria Embankment and Queen Victoria Street are often more manageable.

There are accessible toilets near to the viewing area. There is also a fully equipped Changing Places facility near the Barbican cinema.

Parking

Parking within the event footprint will be suspended from Friday 7th November 2025. If you usually park on an affected road, you should move your vehicle elsewhere the night before, otherwise you may receive a Penalty Charge Notice (parking ticket) and your vehicle might be removed.

Public transport

Currently there are no planned London Underground closures impacting access to the event area. However, we always recommend you check your journey with all network operators should there be last minute or unforeseen issues.

Some bus services will need to be diverted, suspended, or terminated earlier than their usual destination because of the road closures. Some stops will also be temporarily relocated or suspended.



A number of Santander Cycle Hire docking stations will be affected because of the event. Customers are advised to check cycle and space availability online using the live docking station map. For more information please visit: <https://www.tfl.gov.uk/modes/cycling/santander-cycles> Hired E-bikes will be geofence and not permitted into the area of the parade.

Please also note that some on-street cycle parking will be suspended (indicated by signage) and any bicycles left in suspended bays may be removed.
