At the adjourned Court of Wardmote held at the The Parish Hall, St Botolph's Churchyard, London, EC2M 3TL on 14th November 2017 before Alderman Sir David Wootton, Alderman for the Ward of Langbourn, for the election of one Common Councilman for the residue of the current term.

The Alderman read out the number of votes recorded for each candidate, namely:-

A. Abeyie 24; A. Aminu 20; S J Joshi 72 and P T Streeter 57 and declared Shravan Jashvantrai Joshi as a duly elected Common Councilman for this Ward for the residue of the current term.

The successful candidate then addressed the Wardmote and thanked all those involved in the election process including his fellow candidates. Mr Streeter and Mr Aminu also responded and thanked the Beadles and the church staff for permitting the use of the Parish Hall.

Shravan Jashvantrai Joshi being the person so elected then made his declaration and undertaking before the Alderman.

The Alderman and Honorary Ward Clerk then completed the Return to Precept.

It was proposed by Simon Duckworth CC and unanimously resolved that:-
“The results of this election and the name of the candidate duly elected be published on the Ward Notice Board”

It was further proposed by Deputy Wendy Hyde, seconded by Deputy Tom Sleigh and unanimously resolved that:-
“The cordial thanks of this Wardmote be tendered to Alderman Sir David Wootton for his courtesy and ability in presiding at the Wardmote on this occasion”

He returned his thanks together with thanks to the Parish of St Botolph's for the use of the Parish Hall.

There being no further business the proceedings were closed at 8.50pm.
